

Public notice of receipt of financial sponsorship interest

Pursuant to Articles 19 and 151 of Legislative Decree No. 50 dated April 16, 2016, the Fondazione per le Arti Contemporanee in Toscana – Centro Luigi Pecci hereby announces that it has received from Intesa Sanpaolo S.p.A an expression of interest in financially sponsoring the exhibition project entitled “Vivono.
